There are **a few places remaining** on the health focused consultation workshop on the **Central Scotland Green Network (CSGN)**

The **Central Scotland Green Network** will change the face of Central Scotland. It will restore and transform the landscape of an area stretching from Ayrshire and Inverclyde in the west, to Fife and the Lothians in the east. Building on existing greening initiatives in Ayrshire, Glasgow and Clyde Valley, Edinburgh and Lothians, the Central Scotland Forest, the Millennium Canal Link and the Falkirk Helix, the CSGN is identified in the second National Planning Framework (NPF2) as one of 14 national developments.

One of the goals of the CSGN is to ensure that the green network is used by everyone **to improve health and well-being through physical activity and contact with nature**, volunteering and learning outdoors.

The **Central Scotland Green Network Prospectus** was formally launched on Monday 19 April along with an on-line Draft Vision and Work Plan (2010-15). Running in parallel with the formal consultation on the Prospectus and Draft Work Plan, a series of interactive workshops provide partners and stakeholders with an opportunity to learn more about the Network and to contribute their views on strategic themes, regional needs and early actions.

Event details

This interactive consultation workshop, being **run in partnership with the Healthy Environment Network**, will focus on how the CSGN can deliver a range of health and wellbeing benefits.

The workshop will:

- update on the vision, themes and goals of the CSGN, as well as the structures being established to co-ordinate and govern the initiative
- seek feedback on the vision, goals and actions proposed in the Prospectus
- identify how stakeholders are already contributing to the CSGN
- focus on identifying actions that are needed (in the short and longer term) to realise the full potential of the CSGN to improve health and wellbeing
